Illusions: Drawings Meeting the Real World

Challenge: Take a photo that has a drawing layered in front of a person, animal, or landscape.

Enduring Understanding:

 Creativity and innovative thinking are essential life skills that can be developed. Creative ideas can be sparked combining drawing and photography.

Materials:

• Pencil or other drawing or painting media

Resources:

• Video: Ben Heine

 Online: Look at these <u>other Images</u>, which have someone holding a drawing that replicates part of the view in the camera

Steps:

- 1. Research ideas (see above)
- 2. Select a view for your photo.
- 3. On a cut or torn paper sketch the key spots where the forms/lines in the background meet the paper.
- 4. Finish the drawing with pencil shading or other media
- 5. When finished, take at least 2 PHOTOS
 - One with YOU AND YOUR Artwork!
 - One of your Artwork (non-distracting background is best)
- 6. Reflect on your artwork REFLECTION FORM
